## ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

The client named below (“CLIENT”) hereby places the dog(s) referenced below and in the accompanying Daycare Application in the care and custody of Blue Collar Doghouse for daycare services on an ongoing, intermittent schedule.

CLIENT understands and hereby acknowledges that dog behavior can be unpredictable, and accepts that CLIENT’S dog(s) may be harmed, injured or killed while in the care of Blue Collar Doghouse, either inside the daycare facility, anywhere on the premises, or while entering/exiting the building.

CLIENT assumes all risks related to the provision of Blue Collar Doghouse’s services (with the exception of gross negligence on the part of Blue Collar Doghouse), including but not limited to disease, illness, injury, death, theft, escape, fire, natural disaster, or harm to person(s), pet(s), or property.

CLIENT agrees not to sue and to release from liability Blue Collar Doghouse, its owners, agents, employees and contractors from all actions, claims, or demands for injury, loss or damage, regardless of the cause.

CLIENT agrees to bear any and all damages, losses, liabilities, demands and expenses, including legal and professional fees incurred as a result of any damage caused by CLIENT’S dog(s). CLIENT also agrees to defend and hold Blue Collar Doghouse harmless for any liability thereon.

In the event of a veterinary emergency, CLIENT authorizes Blue Collar Doghouse to transport CLIENT’S dog(s) to a licensed veterinarian. CLIENT agrees to pay any and all costs or fees incurred with respect to these veterinary services.

CLIENT agrees that CLIENT’S dog(s) may be videotaped or photographed while in the care of Blue Collar Doghouse, and that Blue Collar Doghouse will own the rights and proceeds of such tapings or photographs.

CLIENT understands that Blue Collar Doghouse may impose a more frequent vaccination schedule than is recommended by CLIENT’s personal veterinarian. CLIENT agrees to abide by Blue Collar Doghouse’s vaccination schedule, as a condition of bringing CLIENT’s dog to daycare.

CLIENT acknowledges that falsifying, misrepresenting, or deliberately withholding information about a dog’s temperament, history of aggression or other potentially dangerous behavior may result in immediate and permanent dismissal from daycare, without refund.

CLIENT understands that this document is a release of liability and contract with Blue Collar Doghouse, and is signing this agreement of CLIENT’S own free will.

CLIENT agrees that the terms of this Agreement shall not be modified except in writing, signed by Blue Collar Doghouse and CLIENT, and that this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Washington.
